POST PROCEDURE DISCHARGE INSTRUCTIONS



DIET/ACTIVITIES

Do not drive or operate hazardous machinery for the next twenty-four (24) hours.

Rest at home for the remainder of the day before resuming routine activities. It is highly recommended that a responsible adult stay with you for the next twenty-four (24) hours.

Do not make any important decisions or sign any legal documents for twenty-four (24) hours.

Do not drink any alcoholic beverages.

V. Do not smoke if alone.

Avoid heavy lifting (greater than 10-20 lbs.) or strenuous exercise.

Begin with liquids and light food (tea, toast, etc.) Progress to your normal diet as tolerated.

Tenderness, swelling, or pain may occur at the IV site where you received sedation. If you experience this, apply warm soaks to the area. Notify your physician if this persists.

Mild throat soreness is common after this procedure. Warm salt water gargle or lozenges, cold drinks, or popsicles of your choice will most likely relieve your discomfort.

Others:

NOTIFY YOUR PHYSICIAN IF YOU ARE FEELING THE FOLLOWING:

✓ Chest pain

Persistent or increasing nausea, vomiting, or headache.

Fever/chills within 24 hours after the procedure (temperature over 101 F)

Severe and persistent abdominal pain or bloating

Leg pain, swelling and shortness of breath.

Increased, excessive or abnormal bleeding.

Significant increase in severity of pain uncontrolled by prescribed medication.

Increased pain, foul odor, swelling, drainage or pus observed at operative site.

Numbness to extremities. Excruciating pain, redness, or swelling at injection site.

DRESSING/WOUND CARE:

Keep dressing dry (TODAY)

Do not shower or bathe (TODAY)

Change dressing as needed

May shower and apply clean dressing

Do not change your dressing until you

have been seen by your physician

MEDIÇATIONS:

Continue all prescribed medications as ordered by your physician(s)

Take medications as prescribed. See prescriptions attached:

You may take NON-ASPIRIN over-the-counter pain medication.
